Short biography of Marijan Marković

Marijan Marković is an Associate Professor of Mathematics at the University of Montenegro. His primary research interests are in complex analysis and related areas of harmonic and geometric function theory. He defended his doctoral dissertation titled Isoperimetric Inequality and Spaces of Analytic Functions at the Faculty of Mathematics, University of Belgrade, on June 11, 2013. The dissertation was supervised by academician Miodrag Mateljević and Professor David Kalaj. The dissertation explores the connection between the isoperimetric inequality and analytic and harmonic mappings, as well as the corresponding function spaces of these mappings.

Since December 2016, he has been employed as an Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, University of Montenegro, and since December 2021, as an Associate Professor at the same faculty.
