

Angelo Sifaleras is a Professor at the Department of Applied Informatics and a Deputy Dean of the School of Information Sciences, in the University of Macedonia, in Thessaloniki, Greece. He is a senior member of ACM and his research focuses on Operations Research and Optimization. Currently, he serves as an Area Editor for the Yugoslav Journal of Operations Research and also as an Associate Editor for the Operations Research Forum by Springer. Furthermore, he served as leading editor for several special issues of peer-reviewed journals (e.g., Optimization. A Journal of Mathematical Programming and Operations Research) and books (e.g., Springer LNCS). Prof. Sifaleras has been invited as a plenary speaker to several international conferences (e.g., ITS 2025, ICVNS 2022, MOTOR 2019, NET 2018, SYM-OP-IS 2017). He has published over 50 journal articles, numerous book chapters, and conference proceedings and he has published papers in well-known peer-reviewed journals (e.g., European Journal of Operational Research, Computers & Operations Research, Journal of Global Optimization). Additionally, he has been involved in recent European (H2020) and also national research projects. Prof. Sifaleras has also served as external evaluator of various research proposals submitted to open grant competitions funded by the Ministry of Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Serbia, by the Russian Science Foundation, and also the EU Framework Program.
